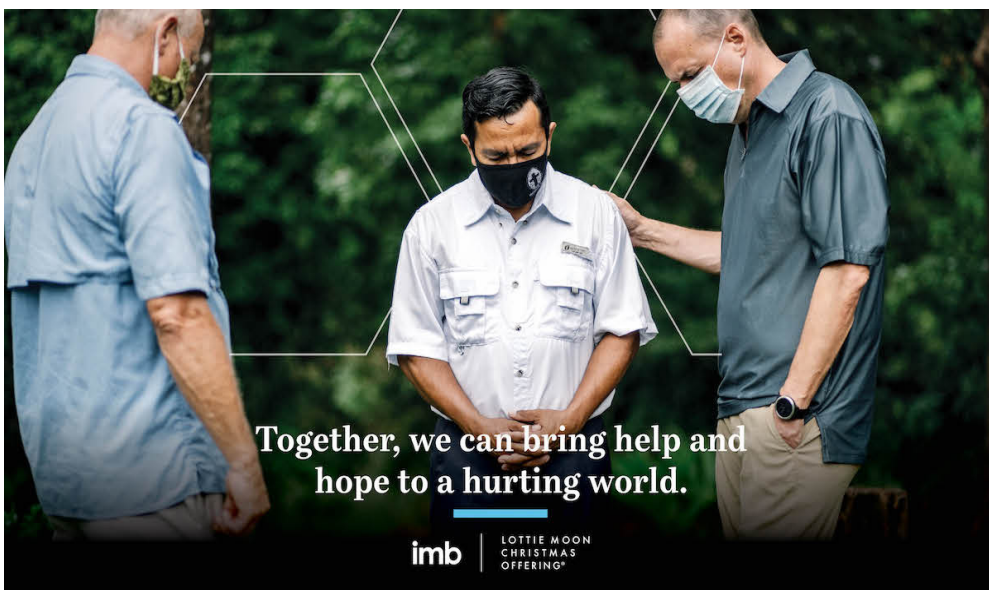

1 During the month of November many church plants and sending churches will be hosting outreach events for their communities. Ask God to use these times to build His church and bring glory to His name.

2 Ahmad and Tagel Muqtasid, New Generation Church, Maumelle. Pray for God's power to be present in their missional efforts. Also, ask God to send more laborers to help with the harvest as they continue to lay the ground work for a new plant.

Ask God to help them be good stewards of the resources given to an impoverished community in reaching young families, the homeless, and those recently incarcerated.
