There are twenty-five centers that receive funding through Arkansas Baptists giving to the Dixie Jackson State Missions Offering. While encouraging a mother to choose life, volunteers also begin a relationship with each woman to support them through the pregnancy and the many "firsts" that come after a child's birth. Parenting classes are very popular at each center.
