Questions for Small Groups:

1. Don't miss the order of Mark 3:14. Jesus first called his disciples "that they might be with him" before he would send them. If they were going to lead others in the cause of Christ, they first needed to learn to live like Christ. Consider your own heart, calendar, and life – Identify two things that need to change for you as a leader to cultivate a closer walk with Christ.

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2. This question requires humility and honesty. Are we making disciples and leading others to make disciples? Are we aiming at seeing God's glory realized in all the earth? Or are we aiming at peripheral activities and ministries that generate busyness but miss the target?
